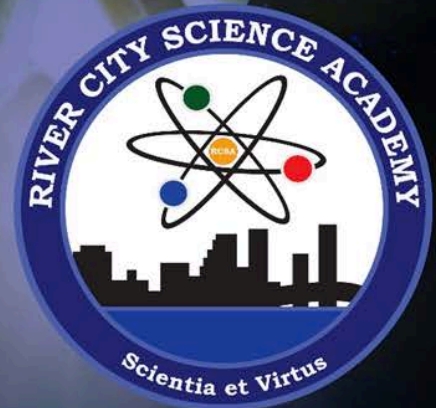

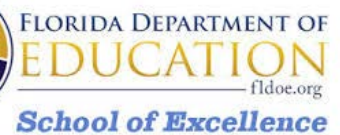

18 Years of Excellence In Education



2007

RCSA is granted a five-year charter contract from Duval County Public Schools (DCPS) in the fall of 2006. After finding a suitable building site, RCSA opens its doors on the corner of Southside and Beach Blvd in August 2007, serving grades 6th and 7th.

2009

Following the 2008–2009 school year, River City Science Academy received an A-grade in just its second year from the Florida Department of Education, becoming the first charter school in Duval county to receive the distinction.



2009 & 2010

In 2009, RCSA opens Phase I of the new building at 7565 Beach Blvd to house 6th and 7th graders. 8th and 9th graders remain in the original location until Phase II completion in August of 2010.

2010

RCSA is the first charter school in Duval County to receive an “A” grade for two consecutive years as well as making 100% AYP in DCPS charter school history. River City Science Academy earns accreditation from the SACS-CASI, AdvancEd (now Cognia) in the 2009–2010 school year.

2011

RCSA hosts the 1st Annual Florida STEM & Health Expo, a science festival that has now grown to welcome over 6,000 people annually.



2010

In 2010, RCSA applies for and is awarded the approval to open RCSA Elementary across from the Middle-High school to serve grades K–5th.



2013

RCSA establishes its third campus, RCSA Innovation, in 2013.

RCSA Innovation is located off Philips Hwy near Baymeadows Rd and serves grades K–8.



2013

In May of 2013, RCSA graduates its first class of seniors.



2014

River City Science Academy receives high-performing status from the Florida Department of Education, a distinction granted to charter schools after consecutive years of high test scores.

2017

RCSA opens its Mandarin campus at 10911 Old St Augustine Rd for the 2016-2017 school year and serves students in grades K-8.

2018

In March of 2018, RCSA Middle-High School competes at the State Science Olympiad Competition in Orlando and took home the gold! The team then travel to Colorado to represent the State of Florida at the National Competition and thus beginning a great tradition of success in Science Olympiad.



2019

In January 2019, RCSA Mandarin earns the Five Star School Award from FLDOE.



This award recognizes schools for their community partnerships, family involvement, volunteerism, student community service, and school advisory committee.



2016

The RCSA Elementary Science Olympiad team places first for the entire state of Florida.

2017

The tradition of KickStart begins - our all-hands staff celebration to start the new school year.

2018

River City Science Academy is nominated and awarded Folio Weekly's Best of Jax Award for Best Charter Elementary School, Best Charter Middle School, Best Charter High School in 2018. The following year, RCSA won Best Kindergarten, Best Elementary School, Best Middle School, Best Charter Elementary, Best Charter Middle, and Best Charter High School.

2019

RCSA Mandarin makes history by placing 2nd place in the regional SeaPerch competition! The team then travels to Maryland to compete in the national competition for the first time.

2019

RCSA Elementary and RCSA Mandarin are deemed Florida Schools of Excellence for their test scores.

2020

RCSA Innovation moves to its new location further down Philips Highway and commissions a beautiful campus mural design.

All six RCSA schools received an 'A' grade and designated as high-performing by the Florida Department of Education for the 2023–2024 school year.

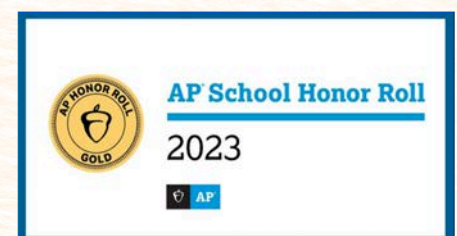

RCSA Middle-High reaches AP School Honor Roll Gold level and estimated to reach Platinum level for the 2024–2025 school year.



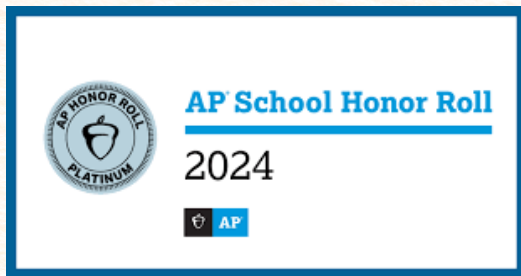

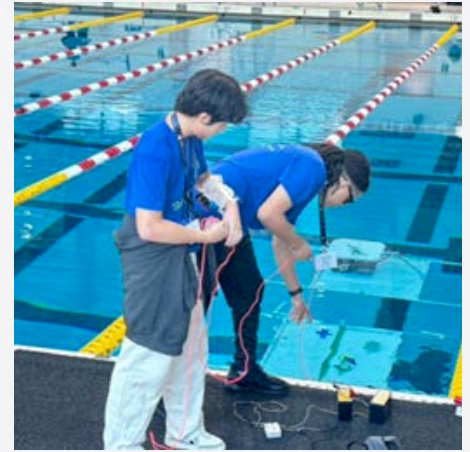


RCSA Middle-High student, Luke Valenzuela was invited to compete against the top mathletes in the **Mathcon Nationals** in Chicago.

Noetic Learning Math Contest:

Out of 40,874 participants, our 6th graders, RCSA Middle-High students Annabelle Stasyuk and Yousof Azaizeh, made it into the top 10% across the country, earning the prestigious title of National Honor Roll.



At the Florida State **Science Olympiad** Tournament in Gainesville, the RCSA Middle-High middle school team, Rockets, placed 4th, and our High School team, RaTs, placed 6th! Across both teams, RCSA Middle-High brought home four 1st place, three 2nd place, four 3rd place, and five 4th place medals.



At the Florida Elementary **Science Olympiad** Competition in Gainesville, the RCSA Elementary team achieved remarkable success, with two firsts and a third place finish.

RCSA Mandarin Team Carbon competed in the regional **Science Olympiad** bringing home 8 gold, 2 silver, and 4 bronze medals. The RCSA Mandarin elementary school team earned medals in all of their events at the Florida State Science Olympiad Competition. Howe Academic World Quest sponsored by the World Affairs Council of Jacksonville. **Academic WorldQuest** is a flagship program of the World Affairs Council network, is a team game testing competitors' knowledge of international affairs, geography, history, and culture. There were over 46 teams making it the largest ever iteration of World Quest in Jacksonville!

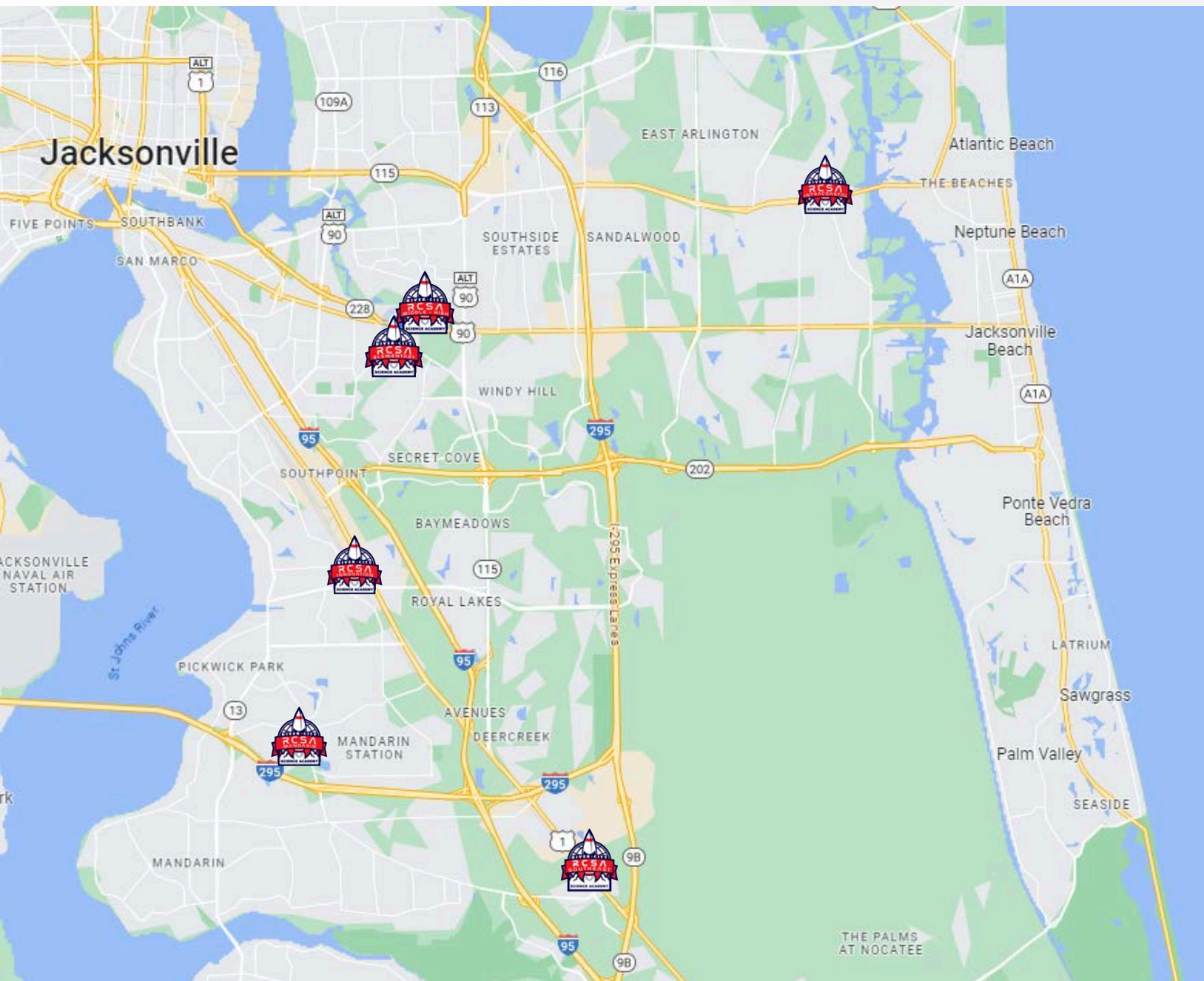
