8. Approval of controlled open enrollment

Students from other counties can go to Duval county schools per legislative changes. RCSA is drafting policies on how to accept potential students to RCSA. A policy was proposed accepting those from another county after Duval county students on the RCSA waiting list are offered placement. If no openings, students will be placed on a waiting list for each respective county. Policy to become effective immediately upon Board approval.

9. Title-I and Title II update

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Title 1: Funding of \$118,768 has been claimed and remaining \$8,432 must be claimed by July 15, 2017. The fund was used as supplementary for staffing and technological items. In addition, there is a \$3,182 fund available and will be claimed for parent involvement programs.

Title II: Funding (\$34/student) proposed use for partial salary of the Reading Coach

Use of funds follows district recommendations for their use and have been claimed as soon as they are available.

10. E-rate update

The E-rate program offers federal funding that pays a certain amount of some utilities (internet, phones –level 1; wiring level 2). The amount received is based on a school's free and reduced lunch population.

YTD, RCSA proposed under E-rate \$101,000 and received \$99,000 for all campuses which helped cover the cost for fiber optic cable placement and other internet services across campuses.

11. Strategic Plan Update

RCSA surveyed teachers and parents and held focus groups to gather information that was put into a strategic roadmap for future growth and improvement of RCSA. Many goals are already accomplished with plans to achieve others.

Business partners at RCSA advisory education committee were presented and asked for input and help to implement the identified goals for example: individuals from University of North Florida, Jacksonville University, MOSH which resulted in positive relationships for RCSA and its students. The Strategic Plan is a living document that is revisited regularly.

12. RCSA Mandarin start-up grant update

Implementation II part of the grant was approved by FLDOE; and School will request additional funds from FLDOE school choice office.

13. RCSA Mandarin phase 2 building update
