Fund Balance 2016-17 SY: Increased to \$2,660,658 from prior year (amount meets 45 days minimum Bond requirements for cash on hand)

b) Elementary: Excess of Revenue over Expenses \$216,315

Fund Balance 2016-17 SY: Increased to \$489,698 from prior year

c) Innovation: Excess of Revenue over Expenses \$181,888

Fund Balance SY 2016-17 Increased to \$335,041 from prior year

d) Mandarin (audit completed) Initial Year in Operation

Excess of Revenue \$151,450

Fund balance SY 2016-17, \$149,232
